



Senior Housekeeper (Contract)

The Senior Housekeeper plays an integral role in maintaining the cleanliness of our site and the health and well-being of our campers, volunteers, staff and visitors during the summer.

Position Specific Responsibilities Include

- Recognizing the needs of Ooch campers and enabling a vision for the overall physical well-being of the site
- Assisting the Manager, Residential Operations (MRO) with training, scheduling, instructing and assessing the work of the Summer Housekeepers
- Assisting the MRO in the development of housekeeping training materials and checklists
- Assisting the MRO with WHMIS/MSDS record up-dating, labeling and other compliance issues
- Attending, participating in and occasionally leading staff meetings
- Supporting camp opening, closing and special events
- Forecasting the need for, and replenishing, stock and supplies
- Performing cleaning duties to ensure a healthy, clean and germ free environment
- Ensuring cleanliness of furniture, fixtures, floors, carpets, walls, windows, appliances and equipment
- Organizing Housekeeping store rooms
- Processing laundry
- Transporting waste and recycling to pick-up points
- Identifying repairs where necessary
- Demonstrating a positive and supportive attitude toward camp residents

Qualifications

- Housekeeping experience
- Supervisory experience
- Comfort with Microsoft Office software
- Valid Ontario Class G driver's license
- Insurable under the organization's auto insurance policy
- Ability to take initiative and adapt to changing priorities
- Ability to work on a team and independently
- Ability to exercise sound judgment in setting and carrying out daily tasks
- Ability to take direction through constructive criticism and direct feedback
- Comfortable performing physically demanding tasks
- Comfortable working in a medically based environment

Particular Working Conditions

In consideration of the population Ooch serves, the incumbent is a non-smoker.

Occasional work during evenings, weekends and statutory holidays will be required to support camper needs.

Physical Requirements

The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions require a variety of physical actions, including: walking, lifting, carrying, reaching, pushing and pulling; bending, stooping, kneeling, crouching, sitting and crawling; mopping, sweeping, wiping and scrubbing; and significant fine finger dexterity.

The minimum physical requirements for this position include the ability to:

- Work at a desk on a computer
- Work at step-ladder height
- Lift 20kg
- Use common housekeeping tools
- Use commercial housekeeping products
- Work in varying indoor and outdoor environments, including uneven terrain and changing weather
